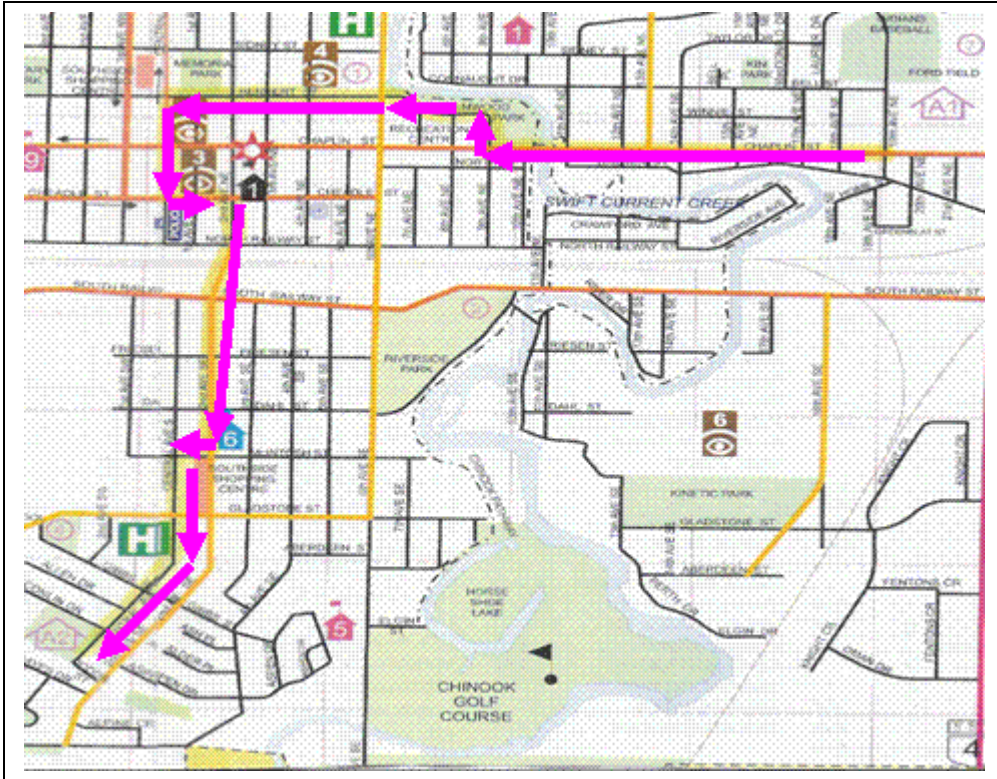

2011 SWIFT CURRENT AGRICULTURAL & EXHIBITION ASSOCIATION PARADE
INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Assembly area will be at the Credit Union i-plex. Floats and other parade entries must enter at the Main entrance of the Credit Union i-plex (Chaplin Street). Ag & Ex Club members will be present to direct you to your designated location.
2. Entries for judging must be in position at the Credit Union i-plex Parking lot by 8:30 a.m., July 1st, 2011. Late arrivals will not be judged.
3. The parade will commence at 10:00 a.m. **SHARP**.
4. If you have candy, balloons, etc. to hand out along the parade route, persons walking beside your entry must distribute them. **FOR SAFETY REASONS, nothing may be thrown from the floats.**
5. Promotional pamphlets of any description must not be handed out or otherwise distributed along the parade route.
6. All horses must assemble in the grassed ditch along north side of i-plex parking lot. Attendants will direct you on where to go. This does not apply to horses pulling floats.
7. To avoid congestion, only registered entries will be allowed in the parade assembly area.
8. Parade entry forms must be received by Friday, June 17, 2011. Last minute entries will be accommodated, if possible, but may be inserted at the rear of the parade.
9. The committee reserves the right to reject or position at the end of the parade any entries other than Agriculture equipment, antiques, restored items that do not have decorations, signage or theme presentations.
10. Parade entrants are responsible for the care and control of any animals entered and the safe handling of all items entered including, but not limited to, steering, braking, safe construction and safety maintenance.

We encourage you to adhere to these guidelines in order to assist us in organizing and conducting the parade.
